

Hiking in the Chimgan Mountains (1 Day)

This interesting excursion will introduce you to one of the most beautiful places in the Tashkent region – the Chimgan Mountains. The Chimgan Mountains are located just 80 kilometers from Tashkent in the [Ugam-Chatkal National Nature Park](#). The peak of Big Chimgan (3309 m above sea level) dominates the vast area.

We offer an exciting, easy hike to the "Red" waterfall, located in the Aksai gorge.

Season: April - June

Length of active part: 7 km

Maximum altitude: 2200 m

Mountain experience required: Not necessary

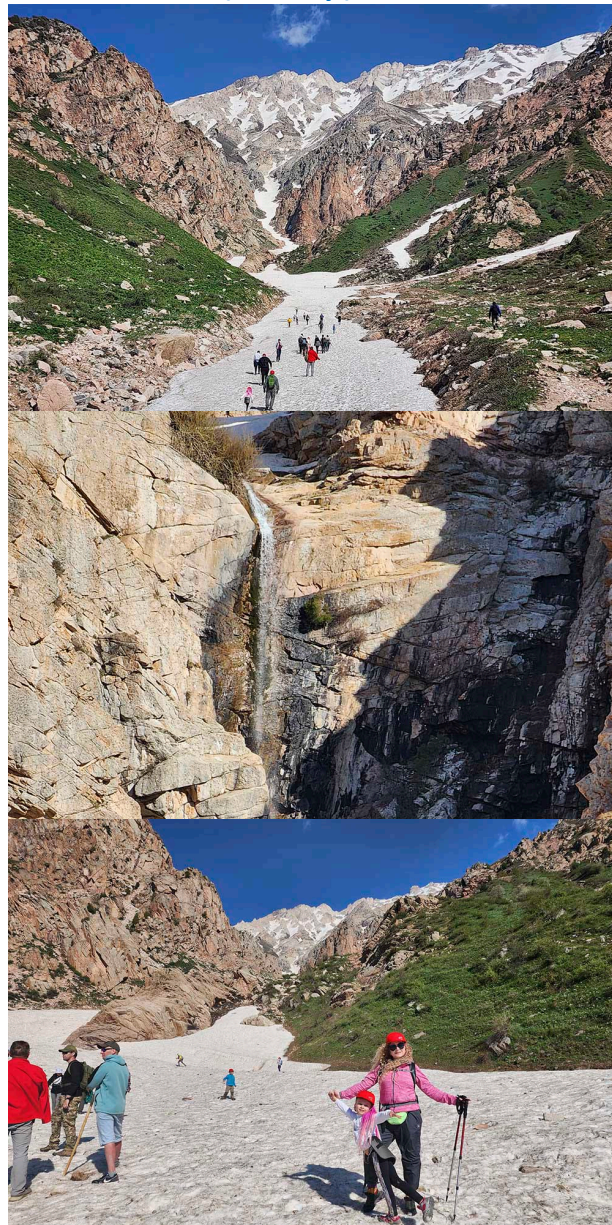
PROGRAM

8:00 - 10:00: Transfer from Tashkent to Chimgan

10:00 - 15:00: (Hiking 7 km; +540 m, -540 m; 4-4.5 hours).

Walk up the Aksai gorge through the Birch grove to the Red waterfall (7 km). The beautiful waterfall is located among red rocks at an altitude of 2200 m above sea level. If time and desire allow, you can also take a walk to the "Black Waterfall" (+2 km) at 2200 m. Snow may still be present here until mid-June.

15:00 - 17:00: Return to Tashkent.
